



## Zoo Camp at a *glance* . . .

### \*Basic Camp Schedule:

For Full Day Camps!

8:00-8:30	Drop-Off and Sign-In for Zoo Campers
8:30	Zoo Camp Start Time
8:30-9:15	Opening Activities
9:15-10:00	Daily Lesson
10:00-11:30	Zoo Camp Themed Activities
11:30-12:00	Keeper Watching Program
12:00-1:30	Lunch and Recess with organized games and activities
1:30-3:30	Zoo Camp Themed Activities
3:30-4:00	Wrap-Up and Prepare for Dismissal

### Sign-In and Sign-Out:

All campers **must** be signed in each morning by the person dropping them off. Campers may only be Signed-Out by approved people listed on your camp registration form. Photo ID **must** be presented at time of pick-up.

### What to bring:

**Lunch**—please pack a lunch for your camper. We recommend an insulated lunchbox.

**Water**—a reusable, extra water bottle is recommended in addition to a drink for lunch.

**Attire**—please dress your camper for outdoor activities. Sunscreen is recommended!

### Early Dismissal:

If your camper needs to leave early for any reason, please provide a note to camp staff. Please include your camper's name, the time they will be leaving, and who will be picking them up.

### Cancellation Policy:

A \$15.00 fee will be charged for all cancellations up to April 30<sup>th</sup>; ½ refund for cancellations after May 1<sup>st</sup>; No refunds after June 1<sup>st</sup>.

### Parking/Drop-Off:

Please follow the Drop-Off and Pick-Up Route. If you need to park please pull into a parking spot. Violators may be fined or towed.

### Medicine:

All medications need to be given to lead camp staff upon arrival. All medications will be stored in a secure location. All prescription medications must be in original pharmacy containers with appropriate information. Camp staff is not permitted to administer medication to your child. It is your responsibility as parent/guardian to inform your child of proper dosage and release the State of Delaware, the Delaware Zoological Society, and all agents and employees from and against any and all claims resulting from your child bringing medicine to camp.
